Ed Code 37220. Public schools shall close:

- 1. January 1
- The third Monday in January or the Monday or Friday in the week in which January 15 occurs, known as "Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day"
- 3. The Monday or Friday of the week in which February 12 occurs, known as "Lincoln Day"
- 4. The third Monday in February, known as "Washington Day"
- 5. The Last Monday in May, known as "Memorial Day"

- 6. July 4
- 7. The first Monday in September, known as "Labor Day"
- 8. November 11, known as "Veteran's Day"
- 9. That Thursday in November proclaimed by the President as "Thanksgiving Day"
- 10. December 25

Note: When any of the holidays on which schools shall be closed falls on a Sunday, the public schools shall be closed on the Monday following. When any holiday on which the schools would be closed fall on Saturday, the public school shall be closed on the preceding Friday, and that Friday shall be declared a state holiday.
