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It shall be the policy of the Tuolumne County Special Education Local Plan Area (SELPA) to provide fiscal and logistical support necessary for the effective operation of the Community Advisory Committee (CAC) in accordance with state and federal special education requirements.

The SELPA Administrator, or designee, shall provide coordination and support for CAC meetings, activities, trainings, and parent engagement efforts reviewed by the SELPA Governance Board. Fiscal and logistical support may include, but is not limited to, meeting coordination, communication support, translation and interpretation services, training materials, facility use, technology support, and other resources necessary to facilitate CAC operations and parent participation.

Each Local Education Agency (LEA) within the SELPA shall support parent involvement through participation in the CAC process and appointment of CAC representatives in accordance with CAC bylaws and applicable LEA policies. LEAs shall encourage collaboration between parents, guardians, educators, and community members to support the educational needs of students with disabilities.

The SELPA Governance Board shall ensure sufficient resources are allocated to support the activities and responsibilities of the CAC as required by law and the SELPA Local Plan.

The CAC shall serve in an advisory capacity to the SELPA Governance Board regarding programs, services, parent education, and other matters related to special education within the SELPA.
