

Notice of Vacancy and Provisional Appointment

(Pursuant to Education Code Sections 5091 and 5092)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a vacancy in the Tuolumne County Board of Education has occurred because of the resignation of a board member in Trustee Area 6 effective March 10, 2026.

On May 4, 2026, the Tuolumne County Board of Education made the Provisional Appointment of:

Jacob Pedersen-Foiada

to fill the above-mentioned vacancy until the 2026 general election.

Those requesting a special election must file a petition with the County Superintendent of Schools within 30 days of the provisional appointment. If no petition is filed within 30 days of the Board's provisional appointment, the appointment shall become effective.

Any petition for a special election must contain the following number of signatures:

(A) If there were more than 2,000 registered voters at the last regular election for governing board members in the County, then:

The petition for a special election must be signed by 1 ½ percent of the number of registered voters of the county at the time of the last regular election for governing board members, or 25 registered voters, whichever is greater.

(B) If there were less than 2,000 registered voters at the last regular election for governing board members in the County, then:

The petition for a special election must be signed by at least five (5) percent of the number of registered voters of the county at the time of the last regular election for governing board members.
