They compete by arguing the case in a Tuolumne County Superior Courtroom.	ACADEMIC DECATHLON GRADES 9-12 February 7, 2026 Open to teams in Amador, Calaveras and Tuolumne counties. Students compete in several academic subjects and the winning teams advance to the California Decathlon.
JUNIOR HIGH SPELLING BEE GRADES 7-9 February 25, 2026 Schools in Tuolumne County send their top three students in grades 7-9 to this annual event. The top two finishers will be able to compete at the state level.	DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION GRADES 3-12 February 27, 2026 Students in 4-12th grades can submit digital images, and students in the 3rd grade can compete by captioning images. The competition is also open to faculty members.
